

## Bicycle Rodeo

### Overview

A one-day Bicycle Rodeo is a fun event that consists of bicycle games of skill and chance. Food, prizes, giveaways, balloons, and face painting make it an engaging experience for the whole family.

### Activity Prep and Execution

Leading up to the rodeo, we acquire bikes from our local Super Thrift store and/or police auction as giveaways for kids who don't have a bike. A complimentary bicycle repair clinic happens for two consecutive Sunday afternoons (4 hours each) where we repair spokes, tubes, tires, for people in the community. The actual event takes place on the third Sunday afternoon (4 hours).

Promotion of the rodeo happens within the community (local media, local businesses, local churches) ahead of time.

### Volunteer Needs:

- 2-3 capable volunteers, able to do bike repairs in a park, church, or Super Thrift parking lot (all three Sundays)
- 2-3 volunteers to hand out rodeo promotional material
- 2-3 volunteers to make hot dogs, cotton candy, etc.
- 2-3 volunteers for face painting and interacting with families
- Master of Ceremony
- Judges for skills and prizes

### Supply Needs:

- A track, trail, or parking lot to ride
- Music and food
- Promotional assistance
- \$200-\$400 to buy bicycle repair parts

### Potential Partners:

- Child Evangelism Fellowship (face painting, etc.)
- Local police for bicycle safety training
- Local bicycle repair supply store
- Local church
