

National Prescription Drug Take-Back Day

Overview

The National Prescription Drug Take-Back Day aims to provide a safe, convenient, and responsible means of disposing of prescription drugs, while also educating the general public about the potential for abuse of prescription medications.

The DEA (Drug Enforcement Agency) authorizes local and county law enforcement agencies that wish to host a collection site for the public to dispose of unwanted pharmaceuticals. This service is provided twice a year in the spring and fall. This is a perfect opportunity for ATC centers to partner and volunteer to assist in these events. The next date is October 24, 2022. Background

According to the 2019 National Survey on Drug Use and Health, 9.7 million people misused prescription pain relievers, 4.9 million people misused prescription stimulants, and 5.9 million people misused prescription tranquilizers or sedatives in 2019. The survey also showed that a majority of misused prescription drugs were obtained from family and friends, often from the home medicine cabinet.

Setup & Prep

- Contact local Police / Sheriff's office for the designated location for the event
- Arrive at 9:00 at location to setup tables and start making balloons
- Projected time of activity: 10:00 am 2:00 pm
- Breakdown & cleanup: 2:00 -3:00 pm
- Contact local TV stations to cover the event

Volunteers Needed (Minimum of 6-10)

- 2 Door Greeters hand out balloons and literature
- 2 Balloon Makers one to fill helium and one to tie the string
- 2-4 Take-Back Table Assistants
- 2 Designated Volunteers to setup and tear down

Supplies Needed

- 2 Six Ft Folding Tables (TC tablecloths if available)
- Project Reach Witness Cards (provided)
- TC Info Brochures, Posters
- 100 Balloons (for kids) https://24hourwristbands.com/shop/products/custom-11-latex-balloons
- Helium tank
- Ribbon / String for Balloons
