

## Prayer Stations

### Overview

Prayer stations are very simple: tables where workers pray for the needs of individuals who happen to be walking by.

### Activity Prep and Execution

Obtain a table, chairs, and some sort of signage that says “Prayer Station.” Set up somewhere with lots of foot traffic, perhaps on a sidewalk or outside a public building. Workers (2-4) can wear “prayer worker” t-shirts, if desired. For a few hours, pray for people as they approach the table. These stations can be maintained for anywhere from 2 hours to a full day.

### Volunteer Needs

- 2-4 workers who are good with people, willing to pray, and not too pushy
  - Make sure these individuals are solid in their understanding of faith and not intimidating

### Supply Needs

- Table
- 2-4 chairs
- “Prayer Station” signage
- “Need Prayer?” t-shirts (optional)
- Cost: approximately \$100 (less if table and chairs are already available)
- ATC and local church/community services literature for the table

### Potential Partners

- Local churches for volunteers
- Community organizations (literature, possibly sponsorship of the signage)
