

Reach Stations

Overview

REACH Stations will allow you to pray for people who have a variety of needs. Praying for others can become an opening for sharing your faith in Jesus Christ and their need for a Savior.

Pray for the person's need first before moving to eternal matters. Focusing on the individual's needs first can often be the catalyst to speaking with them about eternal matters.

Activity Prep and Execution

Spend time in prayer together. Instructions should be given to prepare the team for ministry and team members should be assigned specific roles.

Prepare flyers to hand out to people walking by your station. The flyer should be something that fits your situation. Consider a prayer card or a simple gospel presentation.

Prepare a REACH Station table somewhere outside in your city which will serve as a point of contact for the ministry. This could be a table that displays literature, flyers, contact cards, and pens.

Group 1: REACH Station Invitation Distributor

The distributors should be positioned no more than 20 feet on either side of the REACH Station. They will distribute flyers to the pedestrians walking in the direction of the REACH Station. There should be no more than two people on each side. If someone begins a conversation with you and proceeds to share their needs with you, pray for them yourself—right then.

Group 2: REACH Station Intercessors

Approximately 4 to 6 intercessors should be positioned near the REACH Station—making them easily accessible to pray with those passing by. Remember that most people will not stop for prayer on their own. They will need your personal invitation!

You may want to consider partnering with local churches. That way if someone gives their life to Christ you can have them fill out a contact card so the churches can follow up with them.

Time Requirement

This is completely dependent on how long you want to run the station. If longer than a couple of hours, you may want to consider having those on the team switch roles occasionally. Take breaks if needed.

Volunteer Needs

It is recommended that at least eight people are on a team. Two groups of two on each side of the table and a group of four at the table. Preferably a mixture of men and women.

Supply Needs

- Table and table cover
- Flyers or something to hand out
- Literature
- Gospel Tracts
- Contact Cards
- Pens

Potential Partners

- Local churches
- Other local ministries
- Other event organizers (place a REACH Station at a faith-based music concert or something similar)
